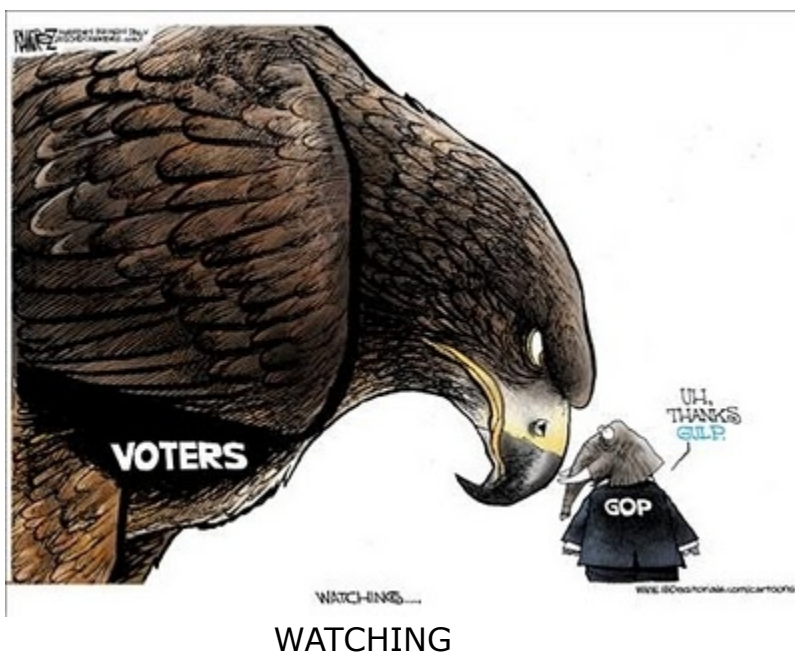
FROM LORRAINE TWEED, President

Legislative Report by Linda Jarrett

The "Lame Duck" session of Congress is about to begin.

While there are a number of issues the Dem majority may or may not choose to consider, there are some particularly important areas of which you should be aware.

Mr. Reid is apparently planning to bring the "Dream Act" back to the Senate floor. The good news is that "NumbersUSA" (an anti-immigration group) is convinced that nine anti-amnesty newly-elected Senators will be effective in working against passage. We need to stand ready to add our voices, depending upon how this battle 'shapes up'.

Regarding the issue of the expiration of the "Bush Tax Cuts" – it would appear that the White House is likely to ultimately agree to an extension of the entire package – but only "temporarily".

While this initially gives a favorable impression, it should be noted that businesses have not been hiring due to another reason besides the poor economy. There is the uncertainty of the effects of the contents of both the so-called "Affordable Health Care" and "Finance Reform" Acts which make it impossible for companies to predict their health care costs and tax load. In fact, the latter prevents recruitment of capital without review and permission from the new Bureau of Consumer Finance Protection! If businesses are to take the risks involved with expansion, they not only need an extended period of stable taxation, they need the removal of the negative effects of these two pieces of job-killing legislation.

Further, in my opinion, the GOP needs to "take back" the topic and define the vocabulary used; the focus should be on preventing all the "Obama Tax Increases" - permanently - including those resulting from expiration of the "Bush Tax Cuts".

As a side note, at the G-20 in Seoul during the week ending 11/12/10, most countries were upset about the earlier announcement that the US would be printing \$800 BILLION for reasons including "infusing money into the economy, and, stimulating lending". **You should be upset too!**

This action "monetizes" our debt, thus devaluing the dollar, and precedes inflation. And, this is after both Mr. Geithner and Mr. Bernanke – under oath – swore this would never be done! Now, there is also discussion of raising our national debt ceiling – yet again! This would seem to portend planned further spending, funded by borrowing – when we desperately need slashed spending!

Obama No Longer 'Most Powerful in World'

Chinese President Hu Jintao has replaced President Barack Obama at the top of Forbes magazine's annual list of "The Most Powerful People in the World." Obama headed the list last year, followed by the Chinese leader. Forbes states that the Democrats suffered a mighty blow in U.S. midterm elections, with the president decisively losing support of the House of Representatives, and barely holding onto the Senate. It's quite a come-down for last year's most powerful person, who after enacting widespread reforms in his first two years in office will be hard-pressed to implement his agenda in the next two."

Feds Shell Out \$1 Billion to Dead People

The federal government has paid out well over \$1 billion to 250,000 deceased individuals over the past decade — and can't figure out how to fix the problem, according to a new report from Sen. Tom Coburn.

"Washington paid for dead people's prescriptions and wheelchairs, subsidized their farms, helped pay their rent, and even chipped in for their heating and air conditioning bills," the Oklahoma Republican's report says.

Among the disclosures, based on a review of government audits and reports by the Government Accountability Office, inspectors general, and Congress:

- The Social Security Administration sent \$18 million in stimulus funds to 71,688 dead people, and \$40.3 million in questionable benefit payments to 1,760 deceased individuals.
- The Department of Agriculture sent \$1.1 billion in farming subsidies to dead farmers.

- The Department of Health and Human Services sent \$3.9 million to 11,000 dead people to help pay heating and cooling costs.
- Medicare paid up to \$92 million in claims for medical supplies prescribed by dead doctors and \$8.2 million for medical supplies prescribed for dead patients.

In some cases, the payments went to dormant bank accounts, while in others they landed in the pockets of living people who are "defrauding the system by collecting benefits meant for a now-deceased relative," according to Coburn's report.

Michelle Obama Ripped for 'Food Desert' Spree

First lady Michelle Obama has the dubious distinction of winning this week's "Golden Hookah" award from CNSNews for her call to spend \$400 million fighting "food deserts."

Food deserts are urban neighborhoods and rural towns with limited access to affordable and nutritious food. Obama is calling on Congress to create a \$400-million-a-year program to encourage the establishment of supermarkets in these areas. "So, while the agriculture bill that's been working its way through Congress includes an earmark of 'only' \$40 million for the program, this week's Golden Hookah goes to the first lady for asking taxpayers to pony up \$400 million a year to pay for her anti-food desert pipe dream entitlement."
