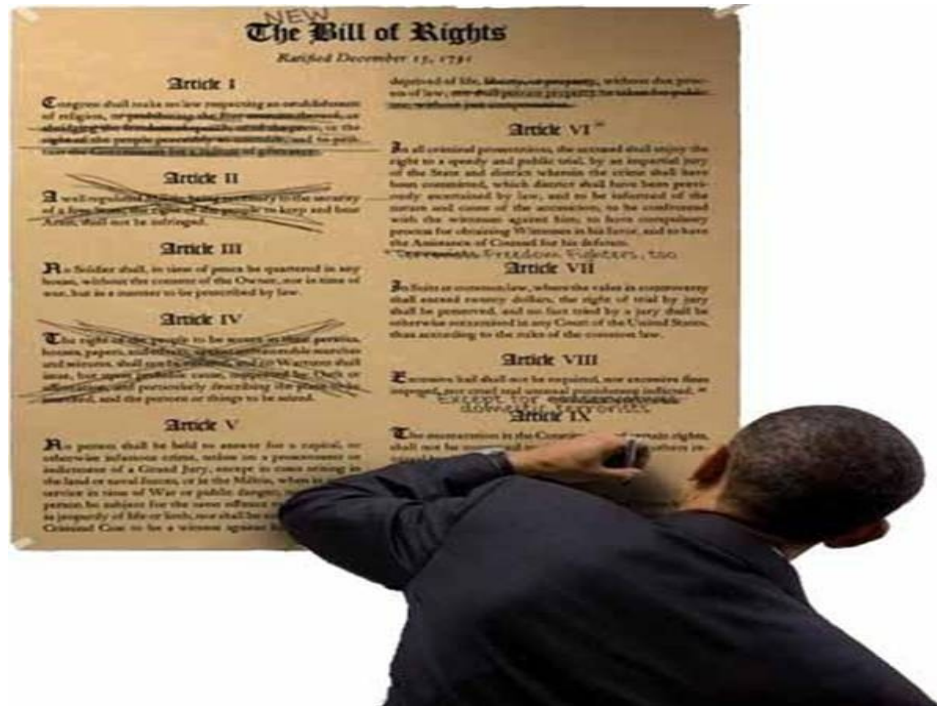

OPPONENTS QUESTION GROUND ZERO MOSQUE'S MURKY FUNDING, MYSTERIOUS SPONSORS

A new \$100 million Islamic cultural center and mosque to be built just two blocks from the site of the 9/11 attacks on the World Trade Center in New York City has triggered a law suit and calls for an investigation into the center's shadowy funding.

Jay Sekulow, chief council for the American Center for Law and Justice likens putting a mosque and cultural center at the site to "putting a monument to Kamikaze pilots at the Arizona memorial at Pearl Harbor" and says he has questions about "where is this money coming from and who is behind it?"

The 9/11 responders he represents are "outraged and shocked at the same time," he says.

"The shock is the idea that this mosque would go up at the same site," Sekulow says. "The outrage is That the government is allowing it, and not only allowing it but is complaisant in it. The irony of this is quite unbelievable.

Former New York Gov. George Pataki tells Newsmax TV that the mosque does not belong anywhere near ground zero and that he questions the financing of the project.

"This isn't the local community corner mosque", he said. "Where are the funds coming from? Are they coming from people who have backed terrorists. We have every right to stand up and say we need to know where the funds are coming from", Pataki said.

When I travel, I have a habit of picking up a local newspaper to get a feel for local issues. This summer, on a 7000 mile cross country trip combining family visits with sightseeing, I had the chance of a lifetime to take a snapshot of news across this great country. Here's what I found.

In Asheville, NC, citizens were concerned about a zoning permit granted for a cement plant. In Hopkinsville KY, residents were worried about an influx of Mennonites – not for their religion – but for their habit of driving horse-drawn carriages down the city's major thoroughfares causing dangerous situations. Lack of local government funding for July 4th fireworks displays was headlined in both Independence, MO and Kansas City, KS.

I was warned about the miles and miles of “nothing but corn” in Kansas, but was pleasantly surprised by the conservatives signs breaking up the landscape. At least a hundred pro-life and religious signs spanned the Interstate; this one caught my eye: “No God, No Peace; Know God, Know Peace.”

As we approached the big city of Denver, CO, issues changed somewhat. Denver is considering 370 billion dollars worth of new water re-use plants since the existing plants are seeing contaminants including traces of birth control pills and antidepressants. In Ft. Collins, CO, there is a local government recall of a Conservative Councilwoman who voted FOR Environmental Reform as well as an ACLU lawsuit to disallow the searching of backpacks carried into the local park for the July 4th fireworks celebration.

Small towns across the mid- and northwest were struggling with state initiated legalization of medical marijuana; in one town, eleven shops popped up within days of the law's passage. Local governments are allowed to opt out and many letters to the editor expressed strong opinions to do so.

Seattle was fertile soil for my research (since my conservative sister lives there). High on her list of issues was the new way of electing U.S. Senators and Congressmen from the State of Washington – the two highest vote getters in a non-partisan primary go head to head in the general election – evidently no separate Democrat and Republican primaries are needed. Seattle seems to have the typical big city issues (traffic, growth, infrastructure), and with Democrats in charge, the money to address them has already been spent.

One small town in Idaho reported a strained budget since they converted their financial reporting documents from DOS to Microsoft. Water prices for city dwellers and irrigation prices for farmers were also on people's minds. An amazing array of Windmill Farms shared fields yielding other crops all along the “fruited plain.” In Pendleton, OR, motorists cannot pump their own gasoline and Oregonians have state income tax but no sales tax (but are considering one.) In Washington State, there is no sales tax, but they are considering a state income tax. Confused?

Des Moines, Iowa residents are working on cleaning up city hall where someone symbolically left a “bag full of bed bugs!” A rural Iowa sign read, “Urban Sprawl, ain't too pretty, Save our farms, build in the city.”

Indiana has a license plate (perhaps a choice of many) that reads, “In God We Trust.” And as we wearily drove closer to home, a handmade sign on I 73/74 read, “pray without ceasing.”

What can we conclude by putting a “finger on the pulse” of America during this four week period in the summer of 2010? I conclude that we have more conservative Americans speaking out than I thought; we have good old American ingenuity at work; we have some of the most beautiful State and National Parks known to man, and despite the difference in specific issues, our freedoms to discuss and debate them inspires Americans everywhere.
