Registration is closed for the luncheon; no more RSVPs are being accepted.



Do you ever wonder where the money you donate goes?


Last month, MRW raised \$2,573 in support of Military Missions in Action; the Men's Club raised \$1,553. Here's what this great organization did with these funds:
