Gordon Chang speaks at April luncheon



"You guys rock!" exclaimed speaker Gordon Chang after listening to announcements before his speech. "You are warriors, and the flame of freedom shines bright in this room!"

An internationally acclaimed expert on China, Gordon was our very special guest at the MRW luncheon on April 5. Among many other things, he shared that:

- The Chinese Communist Party (CCP) sees the US as an existential threat because of who we are - our American values and form of American government.
- China's ambition is breathtaking it isn't trying to compete with us; it wants to overthrow us. Chinese president Xi Jinping believes it's "one ruler, one world."
- The CCP is using three key tactics to accomplish our overthrow Disease, Subversion and Fentanyl.
- China has its own internal crises to deal with including debt defaults, stagnation, food shortages, disease outbreaks and demographic decline.
 Xi has no idea how to fix these problems so he needs an enemy to fight and distract his people.

What can MRW members do?

We must each create "bottom-up pressure" to change our relationship with China:

- Tell your broker to sell stocks of Chinese companies. Sell mutual funds that include these companies.
- Look before you shop don't buy things made in China.
- Push for "COOL" (Country of Origin Labeling) for websites: Products sold on the internet should be required to reveal their country of origin (not the case now).

We encourage you to read Mr. Chang's book, The Coming Collapse of China.
