In North Carolina, municipal elections are non-partisan, meaning candidates are not listed as "Republican" or "Democrat" on the ballots. That's why so many depend on the sample ballots provided by Moore County GOP – we will let you know which candidates are Democrats or unaffiliated, so you can choose a Republican.

But the truth is, in our area, several races will feature multiple Republicans running for the same office. MRW cannot endorse any one candidate but must be "neutral" among the Republicans.
