Following is a list of the speakers we hosted at our monthly meetings in 2020:

November 2021:

- Addul Ali, Chair of the Cabarrus County GOP and Director of the Frederick
 Douglass Foundation of NC, talked about the critical role conservative women
 played in his own life and encouraged us to keep making a difference in the
 world.
- **Neal Robbins,** Publisher, *North State Journal*, announced that the NSJ is creating a local iteration of the paper to focus on Moore County. It will be a conservative and very welcome voice!

October 2021:

 Candidate forum for Republicans standing for office in Moore County's municipal elections. Nineteen speakers gave their "elevator speeches" about why we should vote for them.

September 2021:

- Clare Lopez, Middle East and terrorism expert, related the inside history of the 9/11 attacks and stated that our intelligence agencies were (and still are) clueless. She warned that all of the terrorist groups Hamas, Iran, Hezbollah, ISIS, and al Qaeda are working together to bring down the West.
- Matt Quinn, a former member of the Secret Service who was in New York during the destruction of the World Trade Center towers, provided his dramatic personal story highlighting the heroism of all who tried to save lives that day.

August 2021:

 Dean Jones, Hollywood film-maker and make-up artist who has worked with Stephen Spielberg, David Lynch and others, talked about his career and his new values-based film-making venture in Burlington, NC. • **Jill Stewart,** a guest on Tucker Carlson show, discussed how the CDC unilaterally decided to ban dogs from being able to enter the U.S. from 123 countries, and what people are doing to fight this.

June 2021:

 Hal Weatherman, political consultant currently working for Madison Cawthorn, talked about the heartbreak when Dan Forest lost his run for Governor, and what the GOP needs to stand for going forward.

May 2021:

- Madison Cawthorn, U.S. Representative from western North Carolina, discussed his conservative values and how he and his new wife are planning to meet the challenges of raising children in this world.
- Michael Whatley, Chairman of the NC GOP, explained the new redistricting and how we can increase our seats to send Nancy Pelosi back to California.
