Take action on the Federal Register: Comment by October 16, 2023

In April 2023, Biden's EPA added regulations on gas emissions to cut car sales by 56% over the next nine years.

Now, Biden doubles down with a new regulation to kill gas cars by 2032, raising fuel efficiency standards to impossibly high levels: 66 mpg for cars and 54 mpg for pick-ups.


