3. **Become involved in local governance.** Attend school board meetings. Attend meetings of the Board of Commissioners, the Health Department, and other departments that are of interest to you.
4. **Attend Thursday Think Tank meetings.** Get involved in the Moore County GOP by gathering with other interested Republicans for a weekly review of issues and events. GOP headquarters, 11:00 a.m. every Thursday except the third Thursday of the month.
5. **Volunteer at the Moore County GOP Headquarters.** People are needed to staff the HQ, answer phones, hand out lawn signs, make “reminder” phone calls to Republicans when an election is coming up, etc.
6. **Donate time and/or money to Republican candidates** according to your means. If every North Carolina Republican donated \$5.00 to a candidate, that would amount to a very nice war chest!
7. **Bring a friend or neighbor to our monthly luncheons.** Many Republicans tend to sit on the sidelines – so stimulate them to get involved in a fun way.
