Here it is - the digital version of the Moore County sample ballot that shows those candidates which the MC GOP has endorsed. **This ballot is produced by the MC GOP and is NOT an official ballot produced by any Board of Election.**

Many people have no idea who to vote for if they don't have an (R) next to their names (judges, school board members, etc.) - so help them out! This could be one of the most important things you do this election season.

MRW Luncheon highlights

At the MRW Luncheon on September 14, more than 180 attendees (including political visitors from other North Carolina counties) heard outstanding speakers talk about the upcoming election:



John Bell, NC House majority leader.

John pointed out that it was thanks to grassroots efforts back in 2010 that Republicans took over the state legislature and started our state back on track toward conservative values. He said that similar efforts are needed now - we need to win back our supermajority and the judiciary if conservative legislation is to be passed - and not denied by unelected judges. His formula is "3-2-1": 3 new members elected to the State House to gain a supermajority; 2 new members elected to the State Senate to gain a supermajority; and at least 1 new judge to gain a majority in the State Supreme Court. Moore County has to over-perform to make up for other liberal counties. We can't be complacent, as the "Red Wave" only happens if we do our part.



Jason Jahorek, forensic analyst and private citizen who has analyzed NC's 2020 election results.

Jason sounded the alarm about the fact that NC's 2020 election had many disturbing data inconsistencies which have never been explained. He talked about how easy it is for voting machines to be set up (using computers and/or modems made in China) and hacked. His recommendations for action: 1. Do not vote by mail. 2. Do not vote early. 3. Vote in person on election day if at all possible. 4. Ultimately go back to paper ballots. Visit [his website](#) for more information.

School Board targets academic failure

On an epic night of decision making by the Moore County Board of Education, vice chair Libby Carter disappeared without explanation and thus failed to participate in several key votes.

In her absence, there was serious discussion and debate, which resulted in Carter allies Stacey Caldwell and Pam Thompson abandoning long held positions. The board during its September 12 meeting voted 6-0 to reduce class sizes, decompress qualified staff salaries (to allow real wage growth), adopt an overhauled mission statement and delay plans to renovate school gymnasiums to review lower cost options.

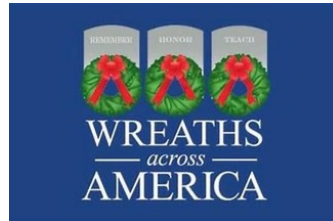

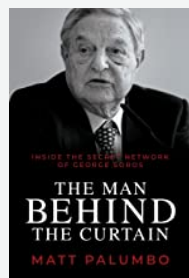
There is also a mail-in form [here](#) if you prefer; however you cannot specify the Sandhills Veterans Cemetery with checks that are mailed in.
