School Board controversy: Setting the record straight



If you read *The Pilot* newspaper, you'd probably be under the impression that there are people out there threatening the School Board over mask mandates. But that is NOT what happened at the School Board meeting last week.

On Monday, September 13, there was a peaceful public rally attended by more than 100 people before the School Board meeting, which had been moved from its original location in West Pines Elementary to the central office in Carthage. There was no security threat to cause the move, but that's not the impression you get from reading *The Pilot*.

Reporters from Raleigh TV stations WRAL and CBS17 were there to cover the rally, drawn by the large and vocal outcry opposing masking children.

Then, after the rally, the board met at 4 p.m., but board member Bob Levy moved to adjourn because the meeting's relocation had not been announced within a required time frame. Anything decided at the meeting would not be binding. The board voted 7-0 to adjourn.

The Board has announced its meeting will be on September 22 in the board room at the Central office in Carthage. This only has capacity for about 20 people, making it next to impossible for the many people who want to speak to be heard.

And that's the true story behind what you're reading in *The Pilot*.

The luncheon concluded solemnly with "Taps," performed by Richard Benjamin, U.S. Marine Corp. veteran.




